
Subject: Report of Webinar on Viral Hepatitis

- The best way to be protected is by getting **TESTED AND VACCINATED**
- If you test positive, **ASK YOUR DOCTOR** about your treatment/management options

PREVENTION THROUGH VACCINE

The **most effective** means of preventing Hepatitis B infection is through **vaccination!**

- 1st shot – at any time
- 2nd shot – 1 month after the 1st
- 3rd shot – Within 6 months after the 1st



You need all **3 shots** to be protected from Hepatitis B.

TRANSMISSION OF HEPATITIS B AND HEPATITIS C


- Direct contact with infected blood or body fluids
- From infected mother to their baby during birth
- By having unprotected sex with an infected person
- Unsafe blood transfusions
- By using unsterilized needles
- By sharing shaving razors, shaving brush, toothbrushes and other personal products

HEPATITIS B AND C

- About **325 million** worldwide in 2015 – are carriers of hepatitis B or C virus infections
- Chronic Hepatitis B is one of the **top 10** causes of death in lower and middle income countries
- The hepatitis B virus is 50 to 100 times more infectious than HIV
- Individuals chronically infected with hepatitis B have a **25% to 40%** lifetime risk of developing liver cancer.
