Findings: The students' feedback with regards to the Teaching-Learning process and institution were collected by using Questionnaire. It was found that the majority of students responded positively on the Quality of teaching, use of ICT tools, encouragement by teachers to participate in extra-curricular activities and the opportunities provided to learn and grow. This shows that the institution strives for holistic development of the students. The students appreciated the fair Internal Evaluation process.
