E-WASTE MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT

This Agreement, entered into on 13th April, 2022 as the "Effective Date" by and between K.S.'s Manjunatha College of Commerce having office at Thakurli(E), Khambalpada, Kanchangaon, Thakurli, here in after called "Manjunatha College" and Threco Recycling LLP, having its office at D-402 Remi Bizzcourt, Shah Industrial Estate, Off Veera Desai Road, Andheri West, Mumbai 400053, here in after called "Threco".

Whereas Manjunatha College has identified E-waste (E-waste as per E-waste Management Rules, 2018) that it may from time to time wish to recycle, and Threco desires to execute a complete waste management program on behalf of Manjunatha College to process the E-waste.

THEREFORE, Manjunatha College shall provide, and Threco shall recycle the Material in accordance with the following terms of this Agreement:

1. Material:

Material is hereinafter defined as E-waste (E-waste as per E-waste Management Rules, 2018). Material specifically excludes equipment containing radioactive materials, free flowing liquids, chlorofluorocarbons, polychlorinated biphenyls, or other "Hazardous Wastes". Threco reserves the right to deny pick up of any E-waste as it may deem fit.

2. Services:

- a. Threco will ensure the E-waste picked up by Manjunatha College is disposed in a compliant manner.
- b. Disposal Certificate, for the applicable material, will be provided to Manjunatha College within 3 weeks from the date of receipt of material at the facility.
- c. Cost of transportation will be borne by Threco.

3. Payment/Charges

3.1 Threco will dispose and pick up the E-waste and pay Manjunatha College Rs.10 (inclusive of all taxes) per kg of E-waste (excluding batteries, cartridges and toners, tube lights, bulbs). Kindly ensure that the collection is enough so that it justifies our transport cost.

3.2 If the quantity of E-waste collected is 500kg or more for a single pick-up the amount payable would be Rs.12 (inclusive of all taxes) per kg.

4. Threco Representation and Warranties:

4.1 In the performance of all Services to be provided hereunder, Threco agrees to comply with all applicable permits, all central, state, and local laws, regulations and ordinances and all duly constituted authorities.

4.2 Threco will be responsible for the statutory compliances including environmental compliances pertaining to the scrap disposal activities and Manjunatha College will not in any way be responsible for the same once the scrap material is handed over by Manjunatha College to Threco.

5 Representations and Warranties:

5.1 Manjunatha College agrees that it has free and unencumbered title to all Material delivered to Threco pursuant of this Agreement.

5.2 Manjunatha College shall issue all proper despatch documents, where applicable.

6 Terms:

This agreement shall have a term of Two (2) years from the Effective Date. Threco will be the official/exclusive E-waste collector and recycler for the institution

7. Independent Contractor:

In furnishing Services pursuant to this Agreement, either Party will at all times be acting as an independent contractor and this Agreement will not be construed to create any association, partnership, joint venture, relation of principal and agent or employer and employee between one Party and the other Party or its agents.

8. Miscellaneous:

8.1 All services performed by Threco for Manjunatha College while this Agreement is in effect shall be subject to its provisions unless otherwise agreed in writing before the performance of such services is started.

8.2 This Agreement may be terminated at any time by Manjunatha College or Threco, upon material breach by either party or upon 30 days written notice to the other party without any reason.

This document constitutes a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between Ashwattha Advisors Private Limited (AAPL) and Karnataka Sangha's Manjunatha College of Commerce

Background

Ashwattha Advisors Private Limited (AAPL), which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of TechnoServe Inc. is conducting a "Youth Employability Program" for enhancement of employability and workplace skills for deserving youth.

1. In this connection, AAPL intends to be associated and work closely with **Karnataka Sangha's Manjunatha College of Commerce** to conduct employability training and career counseling sessions for the final year college students. This will include activities through the year, till students are placed 10-12 months after their final year examinations. Features of the program are as follows:
2. 100-hour program including Personal effectiveness (goal setting, interpersonal relationships), Personal Finance, Professional effectiveness (how to choose right career option, how to apply for job, tools-CVs, cover letter- etc.), Business communication (effective communication with co-workers and customers), Career Readiness (orienting students to jobs matching their skill sets and exposure to a career path) and Work Readiness (Professionalism, Work Ethics, Email Etiquettes, Workplace dynamics - etc)
3. 60 hours of training will be delivered in class and 40 hours of mandatory training will be available to students on TechnoServe's proprietary online learning platform. The program also includes individual student counselling during the program, post training, pre-placement and also post placements.
4. There is no cost for students to attend above mentioned training
5. Each training batch size will be a maximum of 45 students. Sessions of duration 2 hours each to be conducted 5 days/week. Trainings to be conducted for 2 or more batches in one day through one TechnoServe trainer
6. Counselling support is available on training days for providing career guidance to students who are enrolled in this program.
7. Students will be provided a certificate on successful completion of course with a minimum attendance criteria of 90%.
8. Students will be further supported in job linkages and placements from the time of training completion till they are placed i.e. 6-10 months after their training is complete.

1. Objectives of MOU:

The objectives of MOU are:

- a) To promote and enhance Academic Interest between VMC and MC.
- b) To provide advice for implementation of quality of education at VMC and MC.
- c) To exchange faculty and students between the *Institutes*.
- d) To promote research/continuing education both curriculum and co-curriculum activities between *Institutes*.

2. Technical areas of collaboration:

- a) Provide academic interaction by delivering special lectures at VMC and MC on relevant topic.
- b) Provide necessary help in organizing workshops/conferences and personality development programmes between *Institutes* for enhancement of skills in respect of faculty, staff and students.
- c) Provide necessary support for establishment of video satellite link and assistance in development of e-class classrooms, labs, curriculum, establishments of research labs, training and placement and library, etc. at VMC and MC.
- d) Usage of academic infrastructure of *Institutes*' students and faculty members.
- e) To provide summer training for third year students of *Institutes* under Job-Mela programmes, etc.

- 1) To facilitate the training for teachers and PG students.
- 2) Guidance for enhancement in infrastructural development of Institutes.

3. Proposed modes of collaboration:

VMC and MC proposed to collaborate through the following:

- a) Co-operation and promotion of education and training in areas of mutual interests.
- b) Any other appropriate modes of interaction agreed upon between VMC and MC.

A specific plan will be worked out by the Institutes depending upon availability of resources. A specific agreement will be entered into for each activity.

4. Terms and Conditions:

- e) Both Institutes agree to help, identify and invite and the faculty members and researchers from the other Institutes to participate in conferences, workshops and short-term courses.
- f) This MOU may be amended, renewed and terminated by mutual written agreement of the Institutes at anytime.
- g) Either institute shall have the right to terminate this MOU upon 60 days prior written notice to the other institute.
- h) On mutual consent of both the Institutes, review meetings will be conducted once in three months with co-coordinators.

5. Confidentiality:

- a) The Institutes agree to hold in confidence all information/data designated by the Institutes as being confidential which is obtained from either Institute or created during the performance of the MOU and will not disclose the same to any third party without written consent of the other Institute.

b) The above confidential clause under this MOU excludes the information/data possessed by either Institute before entering into the MOU or independently developed and/or information already available through public domain.

6. Duration of MOU:

This MOU, unless extended by mutual written consent of the *Institutes*, shall expire in Three years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. However, on review, the MOU shall be extended for another Two years by mutual consent.

7. Coordinators:

Both *Institutes* will designate persons who will have responsibility for co-ordination and implementation of this agreement.


8. Intellectual Property Rights:

The Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) that arise as a result of joint research and collaborative activity under the agreement will be worked out on a case to case basis and will be consistent with officially laid down IPR policies of the two *Institutes*.
