Feedback Analysis for the year 2017-2018

1.4 Institution obtains feedback on the academic performance and ambience of the institution from various stakeholders, such as Students, Teachers, Employers, Alumni, Parents etc.

Analysis of feedback from students (17-18)

Feedback collected manually from the students regarding teaching learning process and feedback about the institution.

Teaching learning process:

Based on the feedback collected, it seems that the teaching and learning process in the institution is perceived positively by the students.40% of the students agree that 100% of the syllabus will be covered in the class, which is a good indication of effective time management and planning. All the students agree that the institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow, which is essential for overall development. The use of ICT tools for teaching and learning is appreciated by 80% of the students. It can be inferred that the institution is making efforts to adopt modern teaching techniques.

Regarding teachers' approach to teaching, 50% of the students believe it is excellent, while 46% agree that it is very good. It shows that teachers are able to engage with students effectively. In terms of internal evaluation, 60% of the students agree that the process is always fair. This is a crucial factor in maintaining transparency and accountability in the evaluation process. All the students agree that the teachers encourage them to participate in extracurricular activities, which is vital for holistic development. Teachers identifying students' strengths and encouraging them to take up challenges is also appreciated by all the students. Finally, 60% of the students strongly agree that the teaching learning process in the institute is very good, which is a positive sign and suggests that the institution is delivering quality education

About Institution:

Manual feedback collected from Alumni, Parents, Employers, and Students for the Academic year 17-18.

Feedbacks taken from the above stake holders were analysed.

This year the syllabus was revised for SYBCom classes. Some teachers gave their suggestions during the syllabus revision committee meetings held for syllabus revision. According to the feedback, it was decided that college will provide Wifi connection in the classrooms
