## Report

The Students' Satisfaction Survey was conducted by using Google form and the feedback was obtained on Teaching-Learning and our institution. The findings and action taken were as follows:

## A) Findings:

## Teaching- Learning:

$\checkmark$ Nearly $70 \%$ students agreed more than $85 \%$ syllabus was covered in the class.
$\checkmark$ More than $80 \%$ students liked the teaching approach. They agreed that teachers helped them to identify their strengths and weaknesses.
$\checkmark$ Nearly $85 \%$ students were satisfied with multiple learning and growth avenues.
$\checkmark$ More than $90 \%$ students confirmed that the lectures were conducted regularly.
$\checkmark 70 \%$ students were pleased that $90 \%$ teachers used ICT tools in the classroom.
$\checkmark$ Majority of them were satisfied with internal evaluation by teachers.
$\checkmark 85 \%$ students agreed that College provided opportunity for Add-on Courses, Extracurricular activities and Freeships/ Scholarships and Financial Aid.
$\checkmark$ More than $65 \%$ students were aware of POs and COs.

## Institution:

$85 \%$ to $90 \%$ students were satisfied with the easy access to Principal and interaction with the teachers, support from Admin office, Library facilities, Grievance handling, facilities in computer lab, ICT facilities, classroom ambience, safe drinking water facility, sanitation facilities and also campus cleanliness. Approx. 70\% students were satisfied with the canteen facility.

Nearly $89-90 \%$ students were satisfied with Teaching-learning and were positive about the institution.

## B) Action Taken:

$\checkmark$ The survey analysis and its findings were discussed in the staff meeting and suggestions for improvement were noted down.
$\checkmark$ The teachers were instructed to increase awareness about POs and COs by discussing it in regular lectures continuously and motivate them to read it on the college website.
$\checkmark$ In continuation with Add-on/ Value added courses conducted in 22-23, more Add-on courses (Digital Marketing, Basics in office automation) were planned for the next year.
$\checkmark$ The request for purchase of additional LCD projectors in classrooms and computers in lab were placed in CDC meeting.
$\checkmark$ The College Canteen introduced a variety of dishes (medu vada, masala dosa, uttapam), etc. in addition to regular menu (vada/missal pav, soya chilli and bread pattice).
